CEC Awards are as follows:

The CEC-Ohio Teacher of the Year Award

This award recognizes a CEC-Ohio member teacher (nominated by a CEC-Ohio Member) who currently provides instruction to students with exceptionalities and is an outstanding member of the profession. His or her work exemplifies the best in special education teaching and reflects significant, documented positive outcomes for students, continued professional development, and the highest standards of educational quality.

The CEC-Ohio Paraprofessional Award

This award recognizes a paraprofessional (nominated by a CEC-Ohio Member) who currently provides instruction to students with exceptionalities and is an outstanding member of the profession.

The CEC-Ohio Special Educator Rising Star Award

This award recognizes a CEC-Ohio member teacher (nominated by a CEC-Ohio Member) who is in the first five years of their special education career who has shown exceptional potential for leadership in teaching, service, and/or scholarship.

The CEC-Ohio Special Education Lifetime Achievement Award

This award recognizes an individual who has made continued and sustained contributions to CEC-Ohio and positive outcomes for children and youth with exceptionalities in a variety of settings throughout their professional career. Award consideration should be prioritized to individuals with 20+ years in the field and active involvement with CEC-Ohio throughout their career. Nominations may come from any entity related to special education in collaboration with CEC-Ohio.

The CEC-Ohio Special Education Research Award

This award recognizes a CEC-Ohio member whose research has had a direct impact on practice, programs, or policy needs and has improved positive outcomes for children and youth with exceptionalities. Nominations may come from any entity related to special education professional and/or practitioner research in collaboration with CEC-Ohio.

The Outstanding CEC-Ohio Leadership Award

This award honors a CEC-Ohio member who has made significant contributions to the Council's programs and activities at the local, state/provincial, and national/international level over an extended period of time. Award consideration should be prioritized to the immediate Past-President, with board approval.

The CEC-Ohio Outreach & Engagement Award

This award honors a CEC-Ohio supporter who has made significant contributions to advancing the mission of CEC-Ohio and supporting the field of special education. Award nominations should be generated by the CEC-Ohio Executive Board based on organizational collaborations.

The CEC-Ohio Kathe Shelby Student of the Year Award

This award honors a current university student who is studying to become a special education teacher and demonstrates excellence in the field as a future leader.

This award is accompanied by a scholarship of up to \$2,000; amount of scholarship will be determined by the CEC Executive Board each fiscal year, based upon the CEC-Ohio Budget.



More specifically, it involves teaching students how to identify word problem types based on a given problem's underlying structure, or schema.
